2024 Highlights & Community Impact

In 2024, through the grace of God and the generosity of our volunteers and supporters, **dozens of our unhoused neighbors** received direct care, compassion, and tangible assistance.

Highlights include:

- **Emergency Motel Stays:** Providing warmth, safety, and rest during severe winter weather for individuals and families with nowhere else to go.
- Church Winter Shelter Staffing: Partnered with Maureen's Haven Winter Shelter Program, staffing a local church shelter and providing meals, companionship, and prayerful support to guests throughout the season.
- **Winter Clothing Drives:** Distributed warm coats, gloves, hats, and blankets to help those facing the cold.
- **Easter Sunday Dinner:** Hosted a community meal celebrating hope and renewal, shared with guests from local shelters and those in need of a warm meal and fellowship.
- Security Deposit Assistance: Provided security deposits for individuals exiting homelessness and beginning a new chapter in stable housing.
- Thanksgiving Food Baskets & Christmas Gifts: Delivered baskets filled with food and festive gifts to residents of local shelters, ensuring no one felt forgotten during the holidays.
- **Toiletries and Hygiene Kits:** Supplied essential hygiene items to families staying at local shelters.
- School Clothes for Children: Outfitted children living in shelter with school clothes, helping them start the year with confidence.
- Sleeping Bags for Street Homeless: Distributed sleeping bags and comfort items to individuals living unsheltered on the streets.

Each act of service is a reflection of our faith in action — meeting both physical and spiritual needs, one person at a time.

• Total Income: \$15,228.93


• Total Expenses: \$11,126.92
